

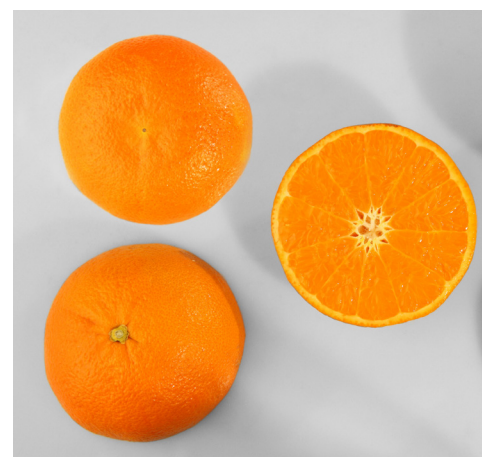

TREE CHARACTERISTICS

Growth habit	Trees are moderately spreading, without thorns
Rootstocks used to date	Carrizo citrange
Alternate bearing	Crop manipulation is required to prevent alternate bearing, and unacceptably large fruit
Alternaria alternata susceptibility	Tolerant

FRUIT CHARACTERISTICS

Fruit size	Calibre 1x – 1xxx (70 – 85 mm)
Fruit shape	Flattish
External appearance	Rinds are smooth to slightly coarse, with a bright orange/red colour
Internal appearance	Flesh is dark orange, with soft fibre
Seed	Fruit have a low seed content in mixed cultivar blocks. Pollen tested with aceto-carmin stain exhibited a 26.92 % pollen viability
