Witkrans Navel - Verbeterde alternatief vir laat navel seleksies

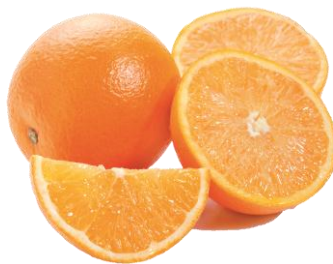
Johann Chris Grobler (JC) is nie net die eienaar van

die Witkrans Navel maar ook 'n bekende karakter agter die Witkrans Kwekery. Die

Witkrans is oorspronklik deur JC se vader ontdek as vermoedelik 'n mutasie van Palmer navel en hy het 'n boord gevestig om die materiaal te toets en te vermeerder. JC het later jare self seleksies gemaak uit die boord wat verbeterde eienskappe ge-

toon het as ander bome. Seleksie E11 is geregistreer en goedgekeur in 2005 as Witkrans. Witkrans is 'n besondere laat navel met goeie uniforme

ronde vruggroote, uitstekende vrug kleur en volhoubare oeslading. 'n Ander kenmerkende eienskap is die goeie vruggroote verspreiding van die Witkrans navel in vergelyking met ander laat navel seleksies. Verdere uitstaande eienskappe is die uitstekende interne vruggehalte en kenmerkende gladde skil. Die varieteit word in laat Julie, vroeg Augustus ryp in die Oos Kaap.



Die varieteit se kommersiële produksie was terug gehou deur die gebrek aan skoon plantmateriaal tot op hede. Skoon plantmateriaal is nou beskikbaar vanaf die Sitrusgrondvesblok (SGB). Die vermeerdering van die plantmateriaal by die SGB sal die beskikbaarheid van plantmateriaal nog vertraag maar kwekerye en boere word aangemoedig om hulle bestellings vroegtydig te plaas.

Ester Granadilla

Citrogold has initiated the process of producing the first virus free Passiflora plant material available to farmers in South Africa. The Ester plant material which is a protected variety, has tested free of viruses.

The first plant material was submitted to the ARC in 2008. The first virus free material has been included in comparative production trials in various locations throughout South Africa.

M7 Navel Field Days

Greg Chislett and his wife Sue visited South Africa in November 2011. Greg is the owner of the M7 early navel and the later maturing Chislett summer hanging navel. (June 2010 Newsletter)

M7 field days were held in Groblersdal, Citrusdal & in Sundays River Valley which were well attended.

The Chislett's were satisfied with the performance of the M7 in various trial sites that were visited. Greg Chislett was also satisfied that the South African M7 source was true-to-type and performing well compared to the original plant material in Australia.

Smith Pomegranate -

Californian growers confirm excellent performance

Pomegranate growers from various countries including South Africa, participated in a tour and field day in California in September 2011.

The Smith pomegranate is a protected early maturing variety that originated from the USA. It is performing well in California.

The Smith is soft seeded, ripens earlier than any other commercially grown variety and produces full red fruit with excellent fruit size. The variety is currently being trialed in South Africa and is showing promising signs of performing as well in South Africa as California.
